David W. Swindells, 85, of Westport, died Sunday, July 31, 2016 at Charlton Memorial Hospital. He was the husband of Sarah (Jones) Swindells to whom he was married for 61 years. During the Korean War, Mr. Swindells served as a communications officer aboard the destroyer USS Power. Prior to his retirement in 1994, he had been Vice President of Labor Relations for the Bairnco Corporation, headquartered in New York City. Before moving to Westport, he lived with his family for many years in Ridgewood, NJ.
