Below please find an outline of the preventative actions taken by the Hotel in the various departments

(Town & Country Inn & Suites

Reunion May 24-28, 2021) USS POWER DD 839 ASSOC.

POSTED OCTOBER 19, 2020

General

Masks are currently required in ALL public areas in the city of Charleston. This includes Outdoor areas and in the hallways of the Hotel.

Guestrooms

All guestrooms are cleaned with a hospital-grade quaternary cleaner that destroys bacteria, H1N1 influenza as well as 10 other bacterial, tuberculocidal and viricidal issues. This product is sprayed on all hand surfaces (telephones, tv remote controls, air conditioner controls, etc.) and allowed to sit for 5-10 minutes to ensure that surface is clean, sanitized and deodorized. Sheets & towels are washed at 130 degrees with level-23 detergent and bleach. All are then rinsed with liquid alkali to bring the pH back to safety for human contact. Vacuum bags are changed frequently.

Trotters Restaurant & Banquet Rooms/Hospitality Rooms

Limited seating with tables at minimum 6' distance from each other. Banquet tables should all be 72" rounds with no more than 6 persons per table. Where applicable, menus are to be paper and disposed of after each use. Buffet is no longer available in Restaurant (a la carte dining only for Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) though buffet setting can be accommodated in a private banquet room. Staff wears gloves and masks and all table items sanitized after use. In both areas, once Guests are at their seat and either eating or drinking their masks can then be removed.

Outdoor Pool

Only stipulation herein regards capacity, which is currently 10 persons in that area.

I hope this helps. These are the requirements as of today — and they have changed at least four times in as many months. I will have a note on my calendar to update you with changes and modifications after the 1st of April.



Website Update for December 2020

As mentioned in previous newsletters there is a statistics collection section that can tell us more information on how our web site is being used, here are some statistics from the internet traffic that took place on our web site in October. Definition of term:

- Unique visitor Number of client hosts (IP address) who came to visit the site (and who visited at least one page)
- Number of visits A new visitor is defined as each new incoming visitor(viewing or browsing a page)
- Pages- Number of times a page of the site is viewed (sum of all visitors for all visits). This piece of data differs from "Hits" in that it counts only HTLM pages as opposed to images and other files.
- Hits- Number of times a page, image, and file of the site is viewed or downloaded by someone.

Our website has links for <u>Project Shad 1962-1973</u>, also <u>Mesothelioma and Agent Orange</u> dropdowns. If you are a Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veteran (Power West Pac Viet Nam cruise from August 1968 to July 1969). The Veterans Act of 2019 (Public Law 116-23, enacted 01 July 2019), in this law you may qualify for a presumption of service connection if you have a disease that is recognized as being associated with herbicide exposure. Agent Orange tab has information to reference that may be beneficial to you in your claim with the VA. Also, note a Facebook link feature on the www.usspowerdd839.org website that will connect you to the USS Power Facebook page, which is USS Power DD-839. Currently, there are 131 members on the public group site. Check out both sites. Remember, you are free to post on the Facebook page your subject matter related to the USS Power at any time. It is never too early to set the date and start planning for the upcoming 2021 ship reunion in May (reunion dates May 24th thru May 28th). 


JUNIOR VICE PRESIDENT
