Paul House, 88, of Phoenix, Arizona passed away on July 22, 2012. Paul was born in Marinette, Wisconsin on November 5, 1923. He joined the U.S. Navy on his 17th birthday in 1940 and served in the Navy for 20 years, retiring as a Chief Petty Officer. On December 7, 1941, Paul was serving on the U.S.S West Virginia when it was sunk in the attack on Pearl Harbor. He later served on the U.S.S Maryland, the U.S.S. North Carolina, the U.S.S. Swivel and the U.S.S. Power and participated in the Battle of the Eastern Solomons and the Normandy Invasion. After retiring from the Navy in 1960, Paul worked for many years with the Arizona Department of Economic Security. Paul was a talented amateur athlete who won many tennis tournaments. He is survived by his wife, Mary House; his sons, Michael House and Patrick House; his daughter-in-law, Annie Alvarado; his grandchildren, Brian House, Karen House Canady and Terrance House; his grandson-in-law, Thomas Canady and great grandchildren, Theren House, Kylie Harris, Garrick Canady and Marina Canady.
